### Sickness/Illness Policy



We ask that you please keep your children at home if they have any of the following symptoms or illnesses:

- Fever greater than 101.5
- Discolored (yellow or green) runny nose
- Questionable rashes
  - Diarrhea
- Active Chicken Pox
  - Measles
  - Mumps
- Conjunctivitis (Pink Eye)

If your child is being treated with antibiotics, he/she should be on the medication for at least 24 hours before coming to the nursery. Thank you for your adherence to these guidelines. We want all of our little ones to remain healthy and happy this season.
